CPSA CONFERENCE

MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES FOR PAPER-GIVERS, AUTHORS, CO-AUTHORS, POSTER AND THREE MINUTE THESIS CONTESTANTS

-Approved on 05.06.04; Amended on 06.12.14, 04.06.15, 18.09.15 and 7.10.16-

The CPSA Board of Directors resolved that:

1. Paper-givers, poster and three minute thesis contestants in our annual conference programme must be members of the Association.
2. Authors and co-authors in our annual conference programme who are Canadian political scientists residing in Canada, whether attending the conference or not, must become members of the CPSA.
3. Authors and co-authors in our annual conference programme who are non-members be invited to join the Association and that if, by the early registration deadline set by Congress and/or CPSA, they have not done so, see their presentation removed from the programme within one week by the Programme Committee Chair.
4. The following authors, co-authors and guests in our annual conference programme will be exempt from the membership requirement:
 - 4.1 Specially invited guests of the Programme Committee;
 - 4.2 Authors and co-authors who do not reside in Canada, are attending the conference, and provide confirmation of a membership in their national association.¹
 - 4.3 Authors and co-authors not residing in Canada and not attending the conference.
 - 4.4 Authors and co-authors from other scholarly disciplines.
